MDC meeting notes

January 12

Lem Howell moved that the Metropolitan Democratic Club of Seattle adopt as its special project for 2022 support for the reelection of Dr Kim Schrier to the 8th congressional district.

January 26

The proposed budget drafted by Eleanor Munro was approved with the exception of the amount for the newsletter. A committee will investigate if there are more economical ways of producing it, such as, electronically.

Other changes included

- 1) donations will be solicited, but not until May
- 2) the line item for meeting space will include Zoom fees

Members also approved, as suggested in the draft budget, raising dues to \$100.

The motion of January 12 to support Dr Kim Schrier for reelection was passed.

Members agreed to discuss Nick Licata's article "The Democrats Can Avoid a Devastating Loss in November" at one of the February Zoom meetings. The article will be sent to members by email prior to the discussion.

MDC votes to support Schrier for reelection

The Metropolitan Democratic Club of Seattle has voted to adopt as a special project for 2022 the support of Congresswoman Kim Schrier for reelection to the 8th congressional district. A motion to that effect was made by Lem Howell at the January 12 meeting of the organization and passed at the January 26 meeting.
